Mr. Liu Daizong

- Daizong is the Director of China Sustainable Cities Program and of China Transport Program of World Resources Institute (WRI) and is responsible for urban (re-)development, transportation and TOD planning projects in China and abroad (Transit Metropolis project, Road safety and low emission zone projects in China)

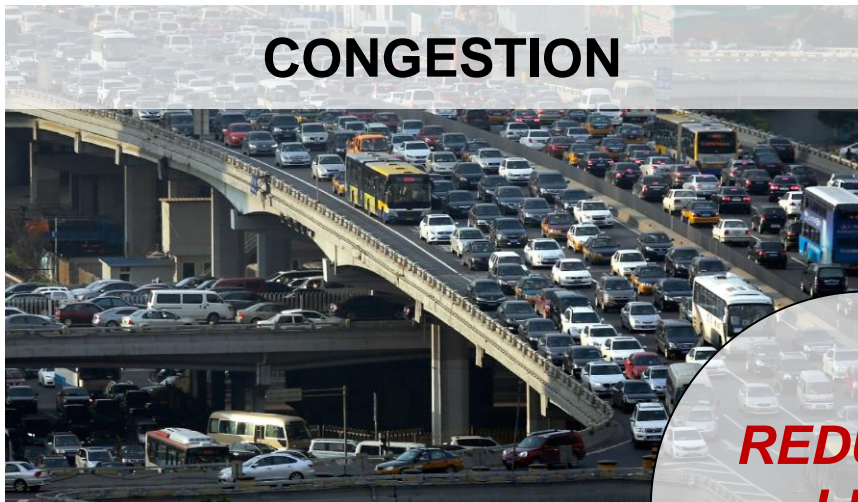
Mr. Pablo Celis

- Pablo is employed in the Municipality of Aarhus – City Road Division, where he works with traffic plans and traffic analyses especially with the purpose of reducing the accidents and insecurity caused by traffic.
- He has been responsible for the making and implementation of a Cycling Action Plan for the municipality of Aarhus. A work that has resulted in a 19 percent increase in the cycling use the last 4 years in Aarhus.

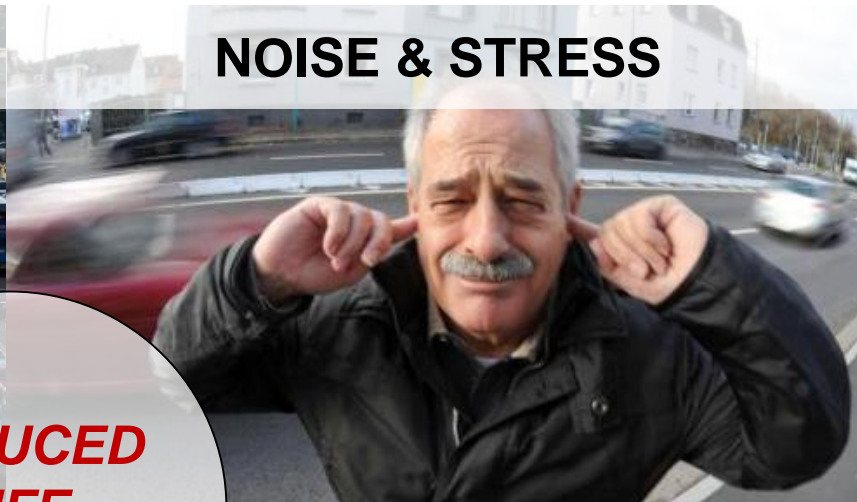
